2025 Cooma Club Championships- Conditions of play

- 54 holes stroke competition played over 3 days, and the winner is the player with lowest gross score in each grade.
- Handicaps will lock on the first round and your grade that day will determine your grade for the championships.
- There will be no "max stroke" rule throughout the 3 rounds, so every hole needs to be played out
- There will be a seeded draw for the final round with the top 4 players from each grade (gross only). Players must play in their seeded positions to be eligible for their respective grade club championship (excludes ladies)
- If after 54 holes there is a tie for gross score in any grade there will be a playoff over 2 holes (1,9) with the winner to be determined by the lowest aggregate score. If there is no result, there will be "sudden death" playoff on the 18th until a result is determined.

Veterans Championship

- There will be a signup sheet in the proshop for the veteran's championship.
- To be eligible for the Veterans championship players will be 60 or older from the date of the first round of club championships (01/11/25)
- Depending on graded seeded draw there may be opportunity to seed Veterans Championship, but players do not need to play in seeded draw to be eligible.
- Players can win both Veterans championship and graded championship.
